23-2024 Season | 1st Year Gear Agreement

Welcome to Homestead Boys Lacrosse! We are excited to have you participate.

For "new to lacrosse" athletes, we offer a 1st Year Gear Program. The program provides lacrosse equipment via rental; at a lower cost. It's a try before you buy program. Rental equipment gives athletes access to the sport before making their own equipment commitment.

Season equipment rental cost: \$200

\$75 of season equipment rental cost is refundable at the end of the season. Refund is contingent upon all equipment being returned and with reasonable wear and tear.

Any player renting gear during the fall that chooses to return all gear by the end of October 2023, will receive a \$175 refund if gear is returned in good condition.

It is the responsibility of the athlete to maintain 1st year gear rental equipment

If there are issues with your equipment during the season and repair or reaplcement is needed, please let your Coach or Danielle Carerra know. Examples are mesh pocket repair, ripped gloves or pads, etc.

DO NOT leave equipment, especially if damp/wet/sweaty in lacrosse bag. Water is the enemy of most sports gear and equipment. Airing out equipment will help maintain its condition and prevent bacteria and fungus, aka MOLD. If any equipment is damp/wet/sweaty, take it out of the lacrosse bag to dry!

Athletes sweat; lacrosse gear smells. Use of anti-bacterial/anti-fungus sanitizing spray may help.

Maintenance and cleaning. Helmet, chest protector and gloves can be cleaned with a damp cloth and sanitized with anti-bacterial spray. When wet/sweaty, newspaper can be stuffed into gloves to absorb moisture. If LAX stick mesh pocket gets muddy, rinse in cold water; push pocket back out and form the way wanted. Place crinkled up newspaper in the mesh pocket to absorb damp/water.

By signing this agreement, the athlete and parent(s) for the 2023 - 2024 Homestead Boys Lacrosse season are agreeing to rent the equipment, maintain the equipment and bag; and return the equipment and bag with reasonable wear and tear.
